CALL FOR PAPERS

Paper Submission

Authors are invited to submit their extended Abstracts (1 page A4 format, max. 3500 characters) in Word format plain text, in Times New Roman font, letter size 12, line spacing: single. The Abstracts must be submitted to e-mail address Ruzanna.Yesayan@energinst.am with topic IRCEC09, or with electronic carrier to the address: Yerevan 0025, Armenia, 5/1, Miasnikyan Ave., Scientific Research Institute of Energy, room 507.

The topics to be covered include, but are not limited to:

- Renewable energy policy, strategy and financing;
- Market trends and barriers;
- Renewable and Clean Energy in the context of the national and regional energy security;
- Issues of international collaboration;
- New technology solutions in the field of Renewable and Clean Energy sources;
- End-use applications: utility, commercial, industrial, agricultural, residential;
- Energy efficient buildings;
- Renewable Energy in the context of environmental protection;
- Practice of implemented or implementing projects;

The Abstracts must be submitted in English or Russian or Armenian and should include:

- the title and the presentation mode: oral, poster, panel discussion;
- authors' full name, position, organization, address, telephone, fax, e-mail address;
- the topic category;
- key words – limited to 10 words;
- Information on when and where the paper was presented previously;
- Concise synopsis 100 words max., in English.

The Abstracts must include the target setting, methodology, results and conclusions.

All abstracts will be evaluated for the material relevance, content matter and novelty. Consultants and manufacturers may submit abstracts of non-commercial nature. Commercial sales pitches will not be accepted for presentation.

Authors will be notified by e-mail if their Abstract is approved after the submission deadline, **5 September 2009**, within 5 working days.

Authors of approved abstracts will be requested to submit full papers along with a detailed CV.

The full papers must be sent to the Organizational Committee by **September 15, 2009**.

Paper Presentation

Oral Presentation

- The estimated presentation time is 15-20 minutes, including Q & A time.
- Registration: One presenter per presentation is eligible for registration to the Conference.

Guidelines for Conducting a Panel Discussion

- Panelists are required to submit the written document of their participation and indicate at least three institutions, administrative bodies or any stakeholders of interest of the panel topic.
- The panel topic must be set up for a complete 1 or 1½-hour panel discussion including confirmed panelists.
- Registration: Up to 5 panelists per panel discussion are eligible for registration to the Conference.

Poster Guidelines

- Posters are to be presented in A0 or A1 paper format. The posters should clearly present the title of the article, the institution/organization and the Author's name as well as the methodology, results and conclusions of the article.

Exhibition

The Space Reservations will be assigned in the order of date received Applications upon the approval of Secretariat.

The exhibitor must submit an application indicating the full title of its organization and the contacts, the title of the model, the application purpose, the picture, the novelty description, main technical characteristics, dimensions and the weight, electricity and other utility connections needed. The Application deadline: **September 12**.

The exhibitor is responsible for providing all booth furnishings; custom formalities and transportation.

Primary Contact Responsibilities

Unless otherwise noted in the abstract, the presenter will be considered as primary contact, responsible for meeting all deadlines and requirements regarding the paper presentation or panel participation. The primary contact must agree to submit a final manuscript of the full paper to be included in the conference proceedings by **September 30, 2009**. This contact also must notify to the conference Secretariat of any changes, additions or corrections in author, co-author or panelist names, paper titles or availability to present the submitted paper at the appointed date and time.
